

Temple paper craft

Print the images from the second page on 200 or 250 GSM paper (if you do not have these print on ordinary paper and glue on cereal box paper) and cut images out as below.



Fold the bottom edge of cut out temple as shown



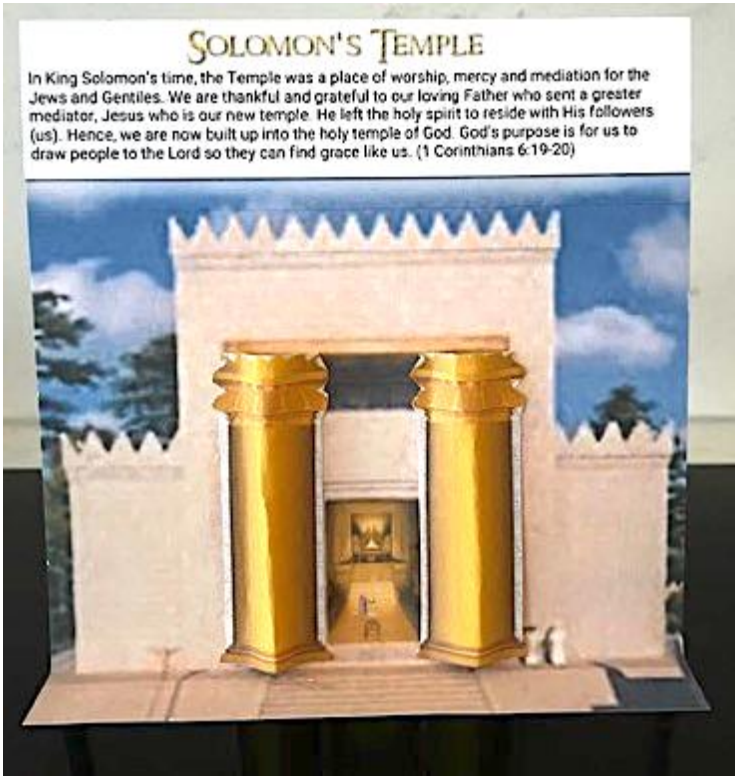
Roll the cut-out pillar images over a marker and make side folds



Cut out spare paper (cardboard thickness) and fold as shown to support



Glue everything together – pillars and back support.
